[REDACTED] and I took a drive out to this place and I took pics....

The cows are knee deep in mud, thin, conditions are worse than pics show. It just doesn't look like any of them have easy access to water etc...

According to a friend of [REDACTED] whose babysitter lives down the lane, she says the babysitter has been trying for years to have animal control take away the animals. They tell her he is protected by a grandfather clause that says as long as they are on his property he can abuse them as much as he wants. (Not sure how reliable this woman is - she's 80 years old).

One cow froze to death in the water that was on his property, it got stuck and froze to death. approx last spring. It has finally been removed. But there are still 2 dead ones in the barn. ALL BUILDINGS ARE NON-ACCESSIBLE TO THE ANIMALS AT ALL TIMES. All troughs are no longer used and sit empty.

The man who owns the property told [REDACTED] yesterday that the buildings are dilapidated and not safe, full to the brim with whatever...

An old rottweiler lives in the last two pics... couldn't see the dog well. [REDACTED] saw him yesterday and said there wasn't much room as the enclosure is all caved in.
