On March 26, 2008 in lieu of neglect charges, you surrendered several fowl, rabbits and horses to Greenfield Hancock County Animal Management. You had indicated that your son [REDACTED], was especially fond of the horse named Stitches. You asked if it would be possible for him to adopt Stitches. I had agreed to give him an opportunity to adopt Stitches provided he met certain criteria. I explained that a home visit would be required, he would need to be able to provide a suitable environment, proper care and reimburse expenses such as veterinary costs. I also explained that the animals no longer belonged to you, that they in-fact belonged to Greenfield/Hancock County Animal Management. Because you agreed to surrender the animals, I told you that I would not charge you with several counts of neglect. I also explained that if and only if [REDACTED] met the criteria stated would I allow him to adopt Stitches.

On April 14, 2008 a home visit was conducted at [REDACTED] property on [REDACTED]. It was determined that this was not a suitable home. Therefore, I have released Stitches to A Critters Chance.
